CHAMPIONS CROWNED AT VICTORY FIELD

2013 State Finals

Baseball enthusiasts from around the state were treated to four exciting, competitive championship games this past June at Victory Field. For the first time since baseball was split into classes, all four games were decided by 1 run, keeping fans on the edge of their seats until the final out.

Friday evening a record crowd of 3,522 came out to watch a rematch of the 2006 title game. In the game, #1 Jasper got on the board first scoring in the 2nd imning to take a 1-0 lead before #3 Norwell was able to push single runs across the plate in the 3rd and 5th innings to take a 2-1 lead that they would not surrender. With the win, Norwell captured its 3rd title in 11 years and first under Head Coach Andy McClain who guided the 2013 Knights to a 33-3 record.

Saturday morning, Vincennes Rivet created early excitement as they scored single runs in the 3rd, 4th, & 5th innings to take a 3-0 lead going into the 6th. Central Catholic got one back in the 6th and 2 more in the 7th to tie it up at 3 apiece before pulling it out with a run in the 9th. With the win, Central Catholic(31-5) won its fifth consecutive 1A title and their 7th overall under Head Coach Tim Bordenet, equaling the number won by Hall of Fame Coach Ken Schreiber.

The 2A game featured the unranked South Spencer Rebels against the #1 ranked Northfield Norsemen. Both teams were able to score a run in the 2nd and it stayed that way until the Rebels scored 2 in the 5th to take a 3-1 lead. Northfield made it tight in their half of the 7th by pushing a run across the plate to make it 3-2 but that was all they could muster as South Spencer(23-8) picked up their 2nd title in three years and third title overall under the leadership of Head Coach Brian Kuester.

Saturday's nightcap saw the #2 ranked Irish from Cathedral face off against the #3 ranked Blazers from Elkhart Central. In the bottom of the first, Elkhart Central got a lead-off home run and that would be all they would need as they held on for a 1-0 win. With the win the Blazers captured their first state baseball title in their first trip to the state finals. Head Coach Steve Stutsman led the team to a 32-1 record for the 2013 campaign.

Attention Coaches

As our association prepares to present proposals to the IIAAA & IHSAA this fall/ winter we are working with the IHSAA to survey our membership. A survey will be sent to your principal and athletic director the first part of September and you need to voice your opinion. It has been conveyed to the IHSBCA leadership that surveys need to have an 85% return rate and that 70% of those returned need to be in favor of a proposal for it to be brought before the IIAAA & IHSAA. Let your administrators know this survey is coming and how you want to respond. The proposals are outlined on page 8 of the newsletter.

SOUTH SWEEPS N/S ALL-STAR SERIES

Fifty of the top seniors from the State of Indiana reported to Wabash College and their beautiful new baseball facility for the 39th annual All-Star Series.

In the series opener, the North got out to an early lead, which would be their only lead of the weekend as the South squad came back for a 7-3 win. In the nightcap, the South bats heated up as the North squad struggled on the mound and in the field. As the dust settled on day one, the South squad closed out game 2 with a 13o victory. The final game of the series on Sunday was played with wood bats and the South won a pitcher's duel, 3-1.

The Don Jennings MVP Award was presented to Alex Krupa of Greenwood High School. Jostens will present Alex with a MVP ring. The North maintains a 61-53 edge in the annual event.

The COTY will be presented their awards at the banquet held during the IHSBCA State Clinic in January. Umpire of the Year recipients will receive their certificates by mail in September.

In 1960 Bobby Richardson became the only player to ever win the World Series MVP from the losing team as the Pirates defeated the Yankees.


Ken Ash is the only Major League pitcher to win a game after throwing only 1 pitch, which he did in 1930 for the Reds.

In 1905, Jack McCarthy, an outfielder for the Chicago Cubs. threw three runners out at the plate in the same inning.



Saturday and Sunday belonged to the South All – Stars as they swept the series by the scores of 7 - 3, 13 - 0, and 3 - 1. Alex Krupa of Greenwood High School was selected MVP of the series and, therefore, received the Don Jennings Award. The town of Crawfordsville and the parents of the all – stars came out in force as the attendance was great all weekend. Wabash College Head Coach Cory Stevens did an outstanding job of hosting and promoting the series. Coach John Froedge and his Crawfordsville High School staff threw some great batting practice on Friday and provided a Hospitality Tent on Saturday that drew rave reviews from the coaches in attendance. Everything was first class and the IHSBCA was truly blessed with Wabash College and Crawfordsville High School hosting this event.

IHSBCA PROPOSALS for the FALL of 2013

The IHSBCA would like for each of you to examine and consider the following items. Each individual proposal needs to be considered on its own merit and not in combination with the others. A proposal will only be submitted by the IHSBCA to the IHSAA if the majority of our membership is in favor of it.

PROPOSAL #1: Would you support the seeding of the Sectional Tournament with the remainder of the State **Tournament (Regional, Semi-State, and State) being done by the traditional blind draw?** (Note: Currently the whole tournament is done with a blind draw.)

PROPOSAL #2: Would you support the elimination of the mileage restrictions for practice and competitions? (Note: Currently, it is 150 miles from the state line for a practice and 300 miles for a contest.)

If you are not in favor of eliminating the requirements, would you support making them both the same?

If you are not in favor of eliminating the requirements, would you support extending the contest mileage restriction 500 miles (for example)?

PROPOSAL #3: Would you support a player to coach ratio of 5 to 1 for off-season workouts? (Note: Currently, it is 2 to 1.)

PROPOSAL #4: Would you support the addition of an optional (not mandatory) courtesy runner for the pitcher and catcher? (Note: Currently this is not an option. This would NOT be proposed as a speed up rule, although it would help in that aspect. It would be proposed as a participation rule to get more players involved in the game.)

PROPOSAL #5: Would you support the starting date for baseball being the same as softball? (Note: Currently softball starts one week before baseball.)
